



## Author Guidelines

EPA submissions are made through ScholarOne. EPA invites previously unpublished papers and high-quality articles that present an emphasis on European countries, issues, and studies, that follow a comparative approach and/or that contribute to the theoretical understanding of policy research.

When submitting a paper, the following documents have to be submitted separately:

- title page (including title, author name(s) and affiliation(s), abstract, 5 keywords, and acknowledgements)
- manuscript (including title, main text and references)
- tables, figures and appendix material (separate files for each of them)

Including abstract, main document with tables and figures, references and appendices, the word count should range between 4000 and 8000 words. The citation style used in EPA follows the American Political Science Association standard.

When submitting an article to EPA, the author(s) pledge(s) to not submit it to any other publication as long as it is under review by EPA. After the review process, the authors are notified whether the paper has been accepted (or not) and whether changes are required before publication. The editors' aim is to keep the review process short.

If, in the submitted article, any kind of material is included that does not fall under the author's/authors' copyright, the author(s) must be granted permission by the copyright owner to use this material. This permission must be available before the manuscript is submitted and refer to any included material of other copyrights whether it is reproduced directly or indirectly (e. g. if the creation of new material is based on a source of foreign copyright). The author(s) is/are responsible for an appropriate acknowledgement of the obtained permission for reuse in all figure and table captions and for any fees for reuse that are charged by the copyright holder.
